**Black And Tan lines up at Flemington on Saturday. Plenty of runners for Prime!!!**

Black and Tan is one of a host of runners wearing our colours over the next week. We are likely to have runners in four states. Victoria will have the most activity with us having up to four runners at the Swan Hill Carnival. Husson Eagle, Invincible Al, Honolulu Lass and Wategos Beach are scheduled to run at the three days carnival.

Black And Tan heads to Flemington on Saturday, Hussy's Glow to Morphettville and Reneged to Randwick on Monday.

Addocarr is likely to run at Doomben next Wednesday (This meeting may be transferred to Toowoomba and 1300m). I was thrilled with his debut with him hitting the line hard and looking like a horse that will relish further. The 1350m race at Doomben should be ideal. He was ridden by Jim Byrne who has been riding the Prime horses for 20 years and is a good rider and judge of a horse. It is

so important that jockeys ride horses to instructions. This is particularly the case with young horses. A bad ride can wreck a horse's preparation and send all the wrong signals to the horse.

Kris Lees has done a superb job with Chalmers who was superbly handled by James McDonald at Rosehill on Saturday. Kris has taken him along steadily and a race like the Grafton Guineas is well within his reach. He is likely to have his next start at Warwick Farm on Wednesday. Casa De Lago will step out to 1600m at Sandown on the same day.

### **Class of 2013**

The sale of Savoureux prompted me to have a look at the results the 13 yearlings I purchased in 2013 produced and continue to produce. This was a great group of horses.

**Our class of 2013 saw all 13 get to the races with all of them being winners.** This crop included some very good horses including the Group or Listed winners **Savoureux, Hijack Hussy, Husson Eagle and Raido** as well as the metropolitan winners **Annaman, Rumeron, Bella Venus, Stimuli, Invincible Me and Makeadane.**

This crop of horses included two Magic Millions race winners in **Husson Eagle** and **Rumeron.**

These 13 horses cost \$633,500 (Ave \$48,730) and have won 48 Races and \$2,478,213 in stakes money to date!!! Husson Eagle, Raido, Annaman and Makeadane are still in our racing team. Hijack Hussy was sold at the Magic Millions National sale in May 2017 for \$400,000 and Savoureux fetched \$200,000 at the 2018 National Sale. To date this crop have returned approximately \$3,108,213 million including sales and I am anticipating the total returns to the owners from this crop will be upwards of \$3.5million once they complete their racing careers.

I wonder what might have been with the two most expensive yearlings I purchased in 2013 dying before we could do anything with them. They are not included in our statistics. I remember being gutted when I lost these two high profile yearlings.

### **State Of Origin**

This is my favourite sporting event and while Queensland have a new look side, I feel they have the experience and more importantly the winning culture drilled into the squad over the past 12 years to get the job done again. Good luck to the supporters of both state sides.

It is great to see the game being played in Melbourne. I know this irks some of the supporters north of the Murray River but Rugby League has come along way in Victoria since the Melbourne Storm first set up shop here about 20 years ago. They have become the most successful club in the modern game and are not out of contention this year. The club received a big bonus when Cameron Smith decided to retire from all representative football.

## Yearlings

Our yearlings are almost fully subscribed. I am tidying up the loose ends and will keep you updated on where we are at. I do have a couple of shares remaining in the Deep Field filly out of Cattalo going to John Thompson. I am pleased with our purchases this year and won't be attending the Magic Millions National Sale.

This filly has broken in exceptionally well with Dan Morton asking if I would leave it with him in Perth but I purchased her for our NSW operation and won't be changing direction with her.

I have been inspecting the progeny of Deep Field at this year's sales but the ones I have liked were bringing more than I was prepared to spend. I found this filly at the Perth Magic Millions Sale and valued her at \$80,000. I managed to secure her for \$50,000 which was a bargain.

She is a very attractive filly. She is well grown and has a great hindquarter. She is also BOBS qualified which is a great advantage and as a result I will send her to John Thompson to train.

The progeny of Deep Field averaged \$219,231 at this year's Gold Coast Magic Millions Sale only behind I Am Invincible, Snitzel and Fastnet Rock on averages which gives you an idea of just how well his progeny were received.

I have had very good success buying out of the Perth Magic Millions. I have only purchased four yearlings with the three to race all being winners. Raido is the best of these and won the Listed Goldmarket Handicap at the Gold Coast recently breaking the race record. This followed on from his December win when he broke the Class record for 900m at the same track.

The other two winners I purchased were Invincible Me which has won five races and Maldicion who won just the one race but had good ability running in the Tasmanian Oaks. Unfortunately, she injured a tendon which finished her career. These three horses collectively cost \$150,000 to purchase and have won 13 races and \$385,233 with two still racing.

### **Deep Field**

Deep Field was a very fast horse five races including two at Group 2 level, a Listed race and he was placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the VRC Lightning Stakes. He has a superb pedigree being by the ill-fated Northern Meteor who looked like being a super star but died prematurely leaving three sire sons including Australia's Leading 2YO Sire this season in Zoustar as well as the highly credentialed Shooting To Win and Eurozone who looks like making a name for himself at stud.

Most good sires have a strong female line and that is certainly the case here with Deep Field being out of the very good race mare Listen Here. She is also the dam of the Caulfield Guineas winner, Shooting To Win.

### **Cattalo**

Cattalo is by the Danehill line horse Tiger Hill who has been a great success as a broodmare sire. Most of his best results are overseas with his best performed runner here being Almandin, the 2016 Melbourne Cup winner.

This is only her third foal. The 2<sup>nd</sup> foal is a Sizzling colt trained by Lee Curtis who has a very good opinion of her.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> dam is by Marscay and was a 2yo Sydney winner. She has had six to race for five winners including the stakes placed Toquite which was also placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the AJC Randwick Guineas.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> dam is the Champion mare Mannerism the dam of the Moonee Valley Oaks and the Group 3 winner and sire Manner Hill.

I was thrilled to purchase this filly and look forward to her wearing our colours.
