This is an exceptional performance. The Magic Millions Race Series is open to horses that were purchased at Magic Millions Yearling Sales and were paid up for the series.

It isn't easy to get runners to the day and the six trainers of our seven horses have done a sterling job with our runners.

Magic Millions offer \$10 million in stakes money for their 'big day'. This is the richest in Australian racing and one of the most lucrative on offer in the world. The races are limited to Magic Millions qualified horses and it is a great thrill for owners to have a runner.

Good luck to our horses and their connections of our runners on Saturday. Our runners with comments on their chances are:

### Gold Coast

Race 1 **Husson Boots** – Tony Gollan. Barrier one with Robbie Fradd to ride. She has been competitive in all her runs to date. Was given a let up after her most recent race and is ready to run well first up.

Race 2 **Lomazzo** – Kris Lees. Pulled up with a slight temperature at his most recent start. In good shape and was good winning a barrier trial recently. Has to overcome a poor gate but has Kerrin McEvoy up which is a big plus. **Naranja** – John Thompson. Resumed with a strong finishing 5<sup>th</sup> under a big weight at Murwillumbah. Drops 9 kg here. Tye Angland to ride.

Race 4 **Annaman** – Tony Gollan. Has a mountain to climb from barrier 16. Jim Byrne rides the horse and knows him well. He choked down at his most recent run and a tongue tie goes on.

Race 5 **Hijack Hussy** – Darren Weir. Returned to form winning at Flemington last start. Loves the Gold Coast track and was favourite for the Magic Millions Guineas two years ago. Worked strongly on the course proper on Tuesday with Damien Lane up. Nice barrier draw.

Race 7 **Flying Jess** – John Moloney. Has had a faultless preparation leading into this race. Couldn't be happier with her and Tye Angland to ride.

Race 9 – **Husson Eagle** - Patrick Payne. Course record holder at 1100m at the Gold Coast and winner of this race last year. Good barrier draw for him. If the speed is on he could easily win the race. Michelle Payne takes the ride and knows him well.

### Flemington and Randwick

Race 4 – **Invincible AI** – Patrick Payne. In great form and nicely in with Tahlia Hope's claim. Very good chance.

Race 8 **Awasita** – Kris Lees. This beautiful mare is in great form and with the 3kg claim and barrier one should be very competitive. Nice each way chance.

We also have Ankara Lass and Quirion running at Kembla Grange.
